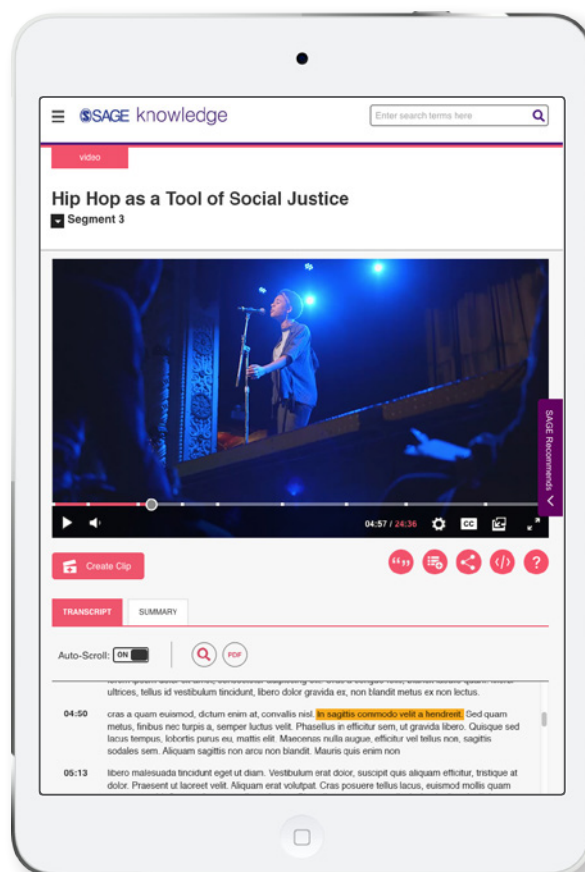
The **Sociology Collection** supports students and researchers at all levels. With more than 60% of content exclusive to SAGE, this robust collection includes the following:

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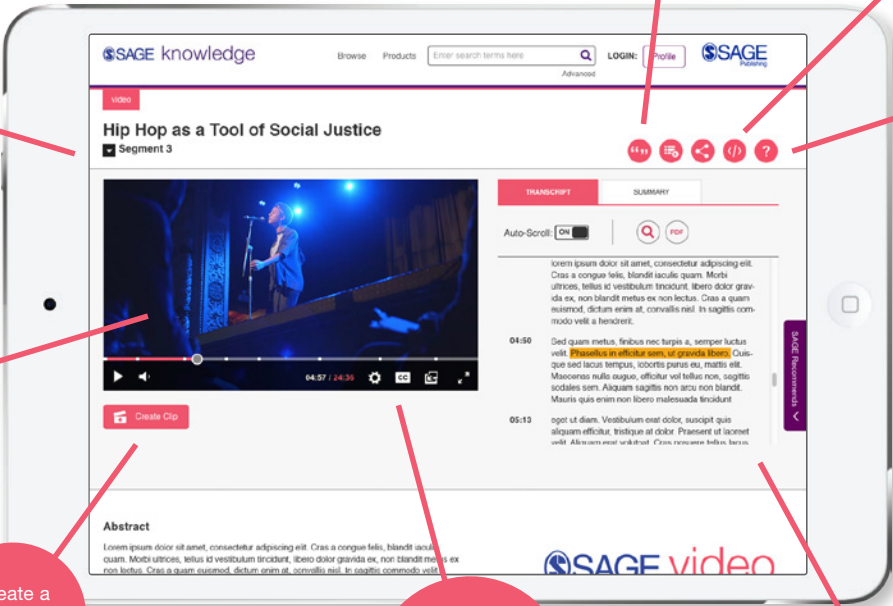

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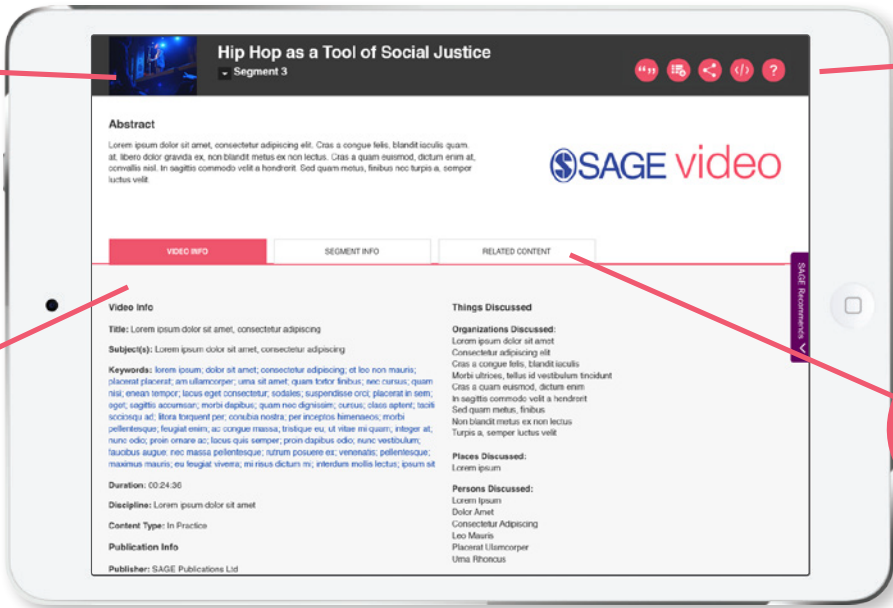
